

National Webinar -Gender Sensitivity Through the works of Literature

The Department of English organized one day National Webinar on “Gender Sensitivity Through the works of Literature” on 26th June 2020 at 11.00am to 12.30pm. The guest speaker to the webinar was Prof.Sumita Roy, Former, Head Dept of English, Osmania University, Hyderabad. Prof.M.Usha was the convener of the webinar. Dr.P.Rajyalakshmi, Vice-Principal and HOD of English and Dr.K.Karuna Devi, member in the Department of English and Coordinator IQAC were the Coordinators to the webinar.

The webinar started at 10.30am and a video on our college was played. Welcome address was done by Dr.K.Karuna Devi, followed by prayer by Ms.Maithri of B.Sc(BZC) final year. Dr.D.Rajeswari, Principal gave her message and she briefed about the college. Dr.P.Rajyalakshmi, HOD of English gave theme of the webinar. Prof.M.Srinivas couldn't come over online for his message. Dr.K.Karuna Devi introduced the Guest Speaker to the participants. This was followed by the Guest Speaker Prof.M.Sumita Roy taking over the session.

Prof.Sumita Roy started her session with first showing the difference of Gender Sensitization. Also feminism is totally different from Gender Sensitivity. Feminism talks about issues relating with only one gender (i.e.,) women where as Gender Sensitivity is address the cause of all. The discrimination in the society is addressed.

She explained Gender Sensitivity through the works of Literature. Quoting many novels she showed how the images representation or pictures or symbols show the gender discrimination and how a teacher has to critically evaluate and sensitize the issues to the students. How the characters are shown powerful depending on the need of the situation it can be male or female or how few dialogues represents gender like male/female/muter she justified to the topic on Gender Sensitivity in the time allotted to her.

It also deals with the quantitative measurement in biological systems.
