1. Best practices-based training and development IQAC and its projects' brainstorming discussions and proposals led to Comprehensive Outcome-based Curriculum Revision for all courses. Short-term skill development courses under the National Skill Qualification Framework and an exclusive Directorate for Applied Short-term courses. Creating a startup environment with incubators, Business Incubation and Innovation Centre, and Innovation Foundation. Faculty development, orientation, and student induction activities enhance teaching-learning. Recommended developing an institutional LMS-Vidyamrutam to establish a hybrid learning system during COVID-19, followed by E-content development workshops and 45 e-contents. Launch of five-year combined Science and Social Science courses and a Joint Master's.

Creating an excellent teaching-learning infrastructure support system: Following IQAC efforts, the following were established: After studying institutional teaching learning needs, creating new teaching departments in Mathematics, AI and Robotics, Food Science and Technology, Nanoscience and Nanotechnology, Data Analytics, and Energy Materials. Establishing an innovation ecosystem with incubators, pilot plants, and co-working spaces for funded companies with Director, IQAC as Coordinator. Completed Gender, Access,

Environment, Energy, and Green Audits and developed policy papers. The audit reports were utilised to effect changes. Advised the institution to construct Academic Bank of Credits. College entry-to-exit system implementation using Student Lifecycle Management. Creating an in-house Faculty Management System to streamline accreditation and rating data gathering. In-house creation of a Journal Management System, Automated Farming System with Sensors, Student Reception Robot, Grammarly software, Solid and Liquid Chemical Waste Management System, etc. Establishment of an Online Examination Centre with proctored and remote test services.


First women's institution to provide B.Com in 1969. The autonomy was granted in 2007. The NEWGENLIB software was deployed in 2011. The institution now has access to e-books and periodicals via its partnership with INFLIBNET – 2012. To teach retail business management, a student canteen operates. A well-equipped gym was created in 2010-2011.

In the 2011-12 academic year, the College introduced CBCS as the second in twin cities. CVW was launched in 2011. All first-year UG students were provided Gandhian and Durgabai studies as add-on courses. Second cycle: Exam branch and office automation software. Attendance biometrics and CCTV placed for workers and students.

The third cycle includes nine self-financing B.A. courses, B.Com (Business Analytics), B.Com (Computer Applications), and B.Com (Tax Procedures) starting in 2020-2021. Implemented online testing and assessment. Due to COVID-19, the e-learning team held many training events for staff and students in May 2020 to strengthen academic abilities and confidence in using online technologies for teaching, learning, and online exams.

Third Cycle: B.A., nine self-financing courses, B.Com (Business Analytics), B.Com (Computer Applications), and B.Com (Tax Procedures), started 2020-2021. Online tests and evaluations were established. Due to COVID-19 in May 2020 For staff and students, the e-learning team held many training sessions to develop academic abilities and confidence in using online technologies for teaching, learning, and online exams.
