Description	<p>Introduction The Andhra Mahila Sabha Arts & Science College for Women (AMSASCW) successfully conducted an online session focusing on the development of Soft Skills and Interpersonal Skills, hosted through Google Meet. This insightful session was facilitated by Dr. GLK Durga, who brought her vast experience and expertise as the retired Principal of AMSASCW to the fore. The program was designed to equip participants with the essential soft skills and interpersonal abilities crucial for personal and professional success.</p> <p>Objective The primary goal of the workshop was to enhance the soft skills and interpersonal communication abilities of students and faculty members. In an era where technical skills are often given precedence, the significance of emotional intelligence, effective communication, and collaboration cannot be overstated. This program aimed to address this gap, fostering a more holistic development of the participants.</p> <p>Program Outline The session commenced at 10.30 AM, with participants joining the Google Meet link circulated prior to the event. 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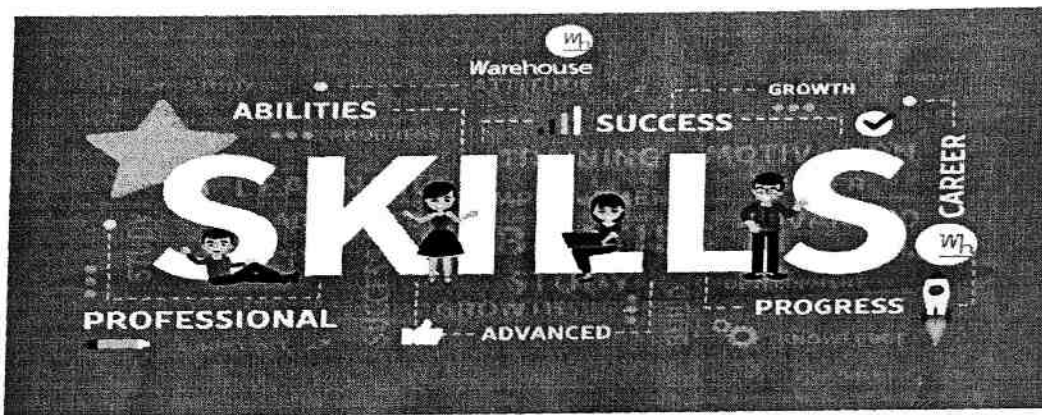

Problem-Solving: Approaches to problem-solving and decision-making in professional settings.

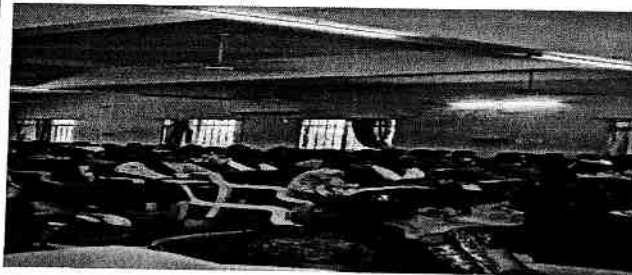
Interactive Activities
