Ms. Y. Vasundhara, Coordinator, Women's Cell introduced the speakers to the audience.

Mrs. Krishna Kumari, Counsellor gave an introduction about Bhumika Help Line and explained its objectives. Bhumika Help Line has been working for 25 years on Women and Child issues in both Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States. Mrs. Krishna Kumari addressed the gathering and said that Bhumika Help Line Students also shared their views and raised many questions, like why the girls are not allowed to go outside to pursue education and for employment? Why they are not allowed to go for higher studies, why the girls are allowed to do only few jobs? Why girls are not allowed to wear jeans, shirts, tea- shirts? There's discrimination even in the food habits of girls. Girls are always must be calm and listen to everybody, should not answer back, even they are not allowed to lough loudly. Whenever girl going to outside, she is accompanied by her brother. All these thoughts were carried from one generation to another. Finally, they concluded that there is a need to speak about our rights, whenever we are exploited by others.

For all the above said questions, the counsellors were given appropriate answers and students were satisfied as they got lot of knowledge and awareness on Gender discrimination.

The women issues related songs were sung by the students. Feedback was taken from the students. They requested the counsellors to conduct more such programmes to create awareness among them. The programme was ended with vote of thanks by students.







A Report on Women Property Rights in India

"Legal Counselling Cell - Aashraya" of Andhra Mahila Sabha Arts and Science College for Women in collaboration with Legal Aid Clinic organized a guest lecture on "Women Property Righs in India " on 29 Dec, 2018 in Room No: 20 at 2:30PM. Around 45 students participated in this programme. Epsitha of B. A First Year welcomed and introduced the speaker Mrs B.Vijetha, Advocate.

She delivered a lecture on how the Government has been taking a number of progressive steps to promote property holding among women in recent times. Section 14 of the Hindu Succession Act, 1956, declares, "Any property possessed by a female Hindu, whether acquired before or after the commencement of this Act, shall be held by her as full owner thereof and not as a limited owner." The Act was amended in 2005 to give equal rights to women. This, came into effect on September 9, 2005, is applicable to the various sects and castes of Hindus, apart from Sikhs, Buddhists, and Jains. Now, a daughter becomes an owner of the coparcenary property by birth right in the same manner as a son does. Widows are also entitled to claim a share equal to that of their children at the time of distribution of the joint family property among the sons.

Schedule IX of the Indian Constitution lists the various laws beyond the scope of judicial review. This Act generally does not grant the same rights to women in inheritance as their male counterparts. In its attempt to plug the problem of defragmentation of land holdings into smaller and smaller parts, authorities have resorted to this remedy. So, in most agrarian states, women don't inherit agricultural land holdings. To better empower the women of the country, the government will have to plug such holes in the system.




