The legal aid clinic under Durga seva Sravanthi in 2014. Since the establishment the clinic is working successfully. During covid 19 the District Legal Services Authority, Hyderabad temporarily not coordinated but legal aid clinic under Durga seva sravanthi continued to reach out students of different colleges at the Andra Mahila Sabha academic campus. Legal awareness campaigns at DDMS Ramchand Girls High School, Intermediate college, AMS Arts and Science College, B.Ed College, AMS School of Informatics uninterruptedly.

The legal clinic re-opened on 02-03-2024 by the proceedings issued by DLSA. On 05-03-2024 the Hon'ble District legal services authority, Hyderabad, Secretary cum Senior civil Judge, Smt Kalarchana garu, city civil court formally inaugurated and also addressed the Degree college students in a legal awareness campaign organized by the In-charge of the clinic B.Vijetha advocate, for the AMS Arts and Science college, academic campus. Total 100 students attended. On this occasion the In-charge of legal aid clinic B.Vijetha advocate and other advocates and faculty of Degree college honoured the Hon'ble Judge Smt Kalarchana garu with shawl.

The clinic proceedings as follows:

- 1) .On 16/03/2024 complainant named Ameena begum approached the clinic for filing maintenance case free legal aid for filing case, prior to this her case counseling done by DDMS legal aid centre , her husband attended but very adamant for compromise talks and refused to give maintenance to her. This matter referred to DLSA,, Hyderabad , that she is resident of Nallakunta.
- 2) On 23/03/2024 complainant named Saleha approached the clinic regarding her months old granddaughter issue, that her son died leaving behind baby girl and wife, afterwards her daughter-in-law left her house and remarrying second time by selling the baby girl for money.To prevent the illegal act. Clinic referred this case to DLSA Hyderabad.

- 3) On 23/03/2024 complainant G.Sukanya approached for advice that her case is in pending at Malkajigiri family court and the free legal aid advocate appointed by the Judge demanded money and under helpless condition she asked advice. The complainant is a literate and able to write affidavit in English. The clinic prepared a memo with explaining the attitude of advocate and requested another advocate. Further clinic drafted one interlocutory application for interim maintenance and advised her to fight her case on her own and the clinic can advise her from time to time.
 - 4) On 30/03/2024 complainant Glemma ,a maid worker in DDMS Literacy House , academic campus, Hyderabad with her sons approached for advice that her case is pending at city civil court, Hyderabad. The case related to temple land and their possession is running without house number, but for the last 40 years they are paying tax, electricity bills and for the last 10 years her son paying tax and electricity bill through gpay. But the counsel not filed any such proofs before the court and also not filed local inspection of advocate commissioner report. The clinic talked to the complainant's existing advocate, and advised him accordingly.
 - 5) On 30/03/2024 complainant M.Jaya approached for legal aid for filing partition suit in respect of her deceased father undivided property.This case mediation tried by DDMS legal aid center but talks failed. The clinic given check list for enclosing documents for filing case. She applied from sub registrar office and enclosed required documents. The clinic referred to the DLSA, Hyderabad.
- The legal aid clinic referred poor litigants cases for free legal aid to the Legal services authority, for Pre-Litigation and for filing cases before appropriate court from the legal services authority panel lawyers and get court fee exemption and advocate fees.
