Infrastructure Upgrades

The college has made significant improvements to its infrastructure, reinforcing our commitment to providing high-quality education. The following are new equipment's and facilities have been added:

- We have added two more digital boards, bringing the total to three, ensuring an interactive and modern learning environment for our students.
- A total number of 8 new LCD projectors have been purchased, increasing the total number to 15, further enhancing the teaching experience in our classrooms.

- To ensure the safety and security of everyone on campus, 17 additional CCTV cameras have been installed, raising the total to 32 across the college and hostel areas.
- 8 new biometric devices have been introduced to streamline and accurately monitor student attendance in both the college and hostel.
- We have also created a new mini seminar hall to facilitate better student engagement and host interactive sessions, workshops, and events.

Collaborations and Industry Linkages, Internships:
