Report on Librarians' Day Celebrations – 2025

Sai Deepika**, attended the **134th Librarians' Day Celebrations** at the University College of Science, Osmania University, Hyderabad. The occasion marked the birth anniversary of **Padma Shri Dr. S.R. Ranganathan**, widely recognized as the *Father of Library Science in India*.

He connected these principles to contemporary trends in information management and technology adoption in libraries.

The event concluded with an interactive session, where students posed questions to the dignitaries, gaining clarity on the intersection of technology and traditional library practices. This exchange of ideas provided a unique opportunity for the NSS volunteers to understand how they can adapt to the changing dynamics of learning and research.

Overall, the Librarians' Day Celebrations proved to be a highly enriching experience. The participants not only honoured the legacy of Dr. S.R. Ranganathan but also acquired a deeper understanding of the evolving landscape of library sciences.
