She said, "We often think our society has evolved, but when we read Premchand, we realise we're still facing many of the same issues." Her words really made us think.

To make the celebration even more special, Dr Vasanta arranged a small prize distribution for the student speakers. The prizes were a book and a pen — something both thoughtful and





#### **Student Participation and Recognition**



#### **Conclusion**


