Dr. G.R. Reddy is a distinguished member of the Indian Economic Service (1971 Batch) with vast experience in public finance and fiscal policy. He holds a PhD in Economics from Kakatiya University and an MA in Economics from Osmania University. He currently serves as a Life Member of the Governing Board at the Centre for Economic and Social Studies, Hyderabad. He has worked as Adviser to the Governments of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh in the rank of Cabinet Minister. He also served as Economic Adviser in the Ministry of Finance, Government of India. Dr. Reddy was associated with the Thirteenth Finance Commission and the Punchhi Commission on Centre-State Relations. He has worked as a World Bank Consultant for international governments. He held senior positions in the Planning Commission and Finance Departments at both State and Central levels. His areas of specialization include public finance management and Centre-State fiscal relations. He has co-authored notable books and published widely in reputed journals like Economic and Political Weekly and The Hindu.

Prof.S.V.Satyanarayana, (Retired),

Department of Commerce, Osmania University, Hyderabad

Dr.S.V.Satyanarayana, a retired Professor of Commerce, Osmania University, served the university for 35 years. He received M.Com., M.Phil., Ph.D. degrees from Osmania University. Apart from teaching, the other responsibilities discharged by him in the University included OSD to the Vice-Chancellor, Chairman Board of Studies, Head of the Department, and Dean of the Faculty. He was also the Research Director, Research and Monitoring Wing for Essential Commodities in Andhra Pradesh for four years. He received the ICSSR Teacher Fellowship to pursue Ph.D. He guided 27 Ph.Ds and 8 M.Phils. He published more than 40 papers in national and international journals. A few of them were in Scopus and ABDC-listed journals. He published 12 books and edited several books. The UGC awarded him a major research project and 3 minor research projects. He organized two national seminars, two international seminars, and conducted 10 workshops. He delivered lectures on invitation at several universities. His scholars hold important positions in various reputable institutions in India and abroad. He received the Best Academic of the Year award twice from the Indian Commerce Association. He received the Best Teacher award from the Telangana Government. He is also bestowed with the 'Teacher of the Teachers' by the Shiva Shivani Institute of Management. Currently, he serves as Professor of Management in Immanuel Business School and also Academic Mentor under the CHEQUE project of Centre for Research in Schemes and Policies (CRISP), guiding the colleges assigned to him for academic quality improvement.

Dr.Krishna Reddy Chittedi is an Associate Professor at the School of Economics, University of Hyderabad, Telangana. He also serves as Guest Faculty at IISER Tirupati and Visiting Faculty at Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University, and has previously taught at the Central University of Karnataka, Central University of Tamil Nadu, and IMT Hyderabad. He received the Prof. M. J. Manohar Rao Young Economist Award (2015) and the prestigious Prof. K. N. Raj Teacher Fellowship (2016) for his academic excellence. Dr. Chittedi has authored three books and published extensively in reputed international journals, with over 2300 citations to his research. He has presented papers at conferences in India and abroad, including France, Russia, and Turkey. He serves as Associate Editor of the South Asian Journal of Management and is on the editorial boards of several international journals, reviewing for over twenty journals. He has successfully guided four PhD scholars, two MPhil scholars, and fifty Master's dissertations, and delivered more than 300 invited lectures across India. He also serves as a subject expert for public service commissions and is a columnist for leading Telugu newspapers, frequently participating in TV debates on economic and social issues. 
