### **What *Pariksha Pe Charcha* Is**

**Pariksha Pe Charcha (PPC)** is an annual outreach by **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** where he talks directly with students, parents, and teachers about examinations, stress management, confidence, life skills and holistic learning. It encourages a positive mindset toward exams — viewing them as part of learning rather than a source of fear. The programme started in **2018** and has grown in scope and participation over the years.

### **Date & Format**

- Held on **6 February 2026** (9th edition), starting at around **10 AM IST**.
- The interactive session is broadcast live on **Doordarshan, YouTube, Facebook, radio and online platforms**, ensuring nationwide access.

### **Scale & Participation**

- This year's edition saw unprecedented participation. Official figures show over 6.76 crore participants (including students, teachers, and parents) — the highest since the initiative began
- It was a **pan-India engagement**, with regional interactions conducted simultaneously beyond the national capital — including cities like **Coimbatore, Raipur, Guwahati and Dev Mogra**.

### **Key Focuses of PPC 2026**

- **Stress Management:** PM Modi emphasized reducing exam-related stress, urging students to focus on building fundamentals rather than shortcuts.

- **Parents' Role:** He asked parents to ease pressure, respect each child's learning pace, and support them emotionally.
- **Life Skills & Growth:** Stress was not just on marks but also on developing **confidence, time management, resilience and holistic personal growth.**
- **Cultural & Inclusive Touch:** The programme began with a traditional **Assamese 'Gamosa'** gesture, symbolizing cultural unity and emphasizing inclusive participation.

## **Evolving Impact of the Programme**

### **Growth Over Years**

- The initiative began in **2018** as a smaller interactive platform. Since then, **participation has surged** — from tens of lakhs to **tens of crores** of participants, reflecting its growing national reach and appeal.
- Between 2023 and 2025, registrations grew from under a crore to over **3.5 crore** (earning a **Guinness World Record**), and 2026 has gone even further.
- **Broader Themes** The programme underscores **exams as milestones** rather than measures of worth, and emphasises **emotional support**, broad skill development, and positivity alongside academic effort.

### **Practical Takeaways Shared by PM Modi**

In various editions, including PPC 2024 and 2025, PM Modi has offered practical advice that continued in 2026:

- **Practice writing answers and time management.**
- **Avoid excessive distractions (e.g., mobile phones).**
- **Emphasize life skills over rote memorization.**

### **How People Participate**

- Students, parents, and teachers register via the official **MyGov platform.**
- A subset of participants is selected each year for direct interaction.
- Certificates of participation are issued to all eligible registrants.
