### **Introduction**

### **1. Orientation Programs**

On February 15th and 16th, 2024, we conducted an orientation program for the BBA Health Care Management course in collaboration with the HSSC faculty. This initiative aimed to provide a comprehensive introduction to the program and foster a conducive learning environment for our students.

### **3. New Courses**

We have introduced several new courses to cater to the evolving needs of our student community:

- **BSc (Honours) in Computer Science:** 23 students enrolled.
- **BBA Health Care and Management:** 18 students enrolled.
- **BSc in Fashion Design and Technology:** No enrolments reported.

### **5. Student Strength**

Our institution continues to attract a significant number of students across various disciplines. In the academic year 2023-24, we admitted a total of 604 undergraduate and 118 postgraduate students.

## 6. Entrepreneurship Leadership Development Programme (ELDP)

Under the visionary leadership of our Chairman, Sri. D. Chakrapani, IAS, we initiated the ELDP in collaboration with esteemed organizations. This program aims to nurture entrepreneurial talent and empower our students with the requisite skills and knowledge.

- **Lucknow ELDP Program:** Sponsored by Sri Day Veerlapati, CEO of S2 Tech, USA, this program saw participation from students of Andhra Mahila Sabha Arts and Science College for Women and IIM Lucknow. Out of numerous applicants, 100 students were selected and successfully completed the course.
- **UDAIPUR ELDP Program:** The IIMU Incubation Center Program, spanning approximately 13 weeks, engaged 64 participants, including 50 students from AMS and 10 students from Nirva. The program provided comprehensive guidance across various facets of startup development and management.
- **IC IIT Patna ELDP Program:** Commencing on August 8, 2023, and concluding on November 28, 2023, this program engaged 65 participants, including 50 students from AMS and 10 students from Nirva. Participants accessed the program via LMS credentials and participated in 21 sessions facilitated by experts.
