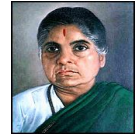




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Report on the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking Programme at Rashtrapati Nilayam

The International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking was observed at Rashtrapati Nilayam, Secunderabad, on 27 June 2026 with the objective of creating awareness about the harmful effects of drug abuse and promoting a drug-free society.
