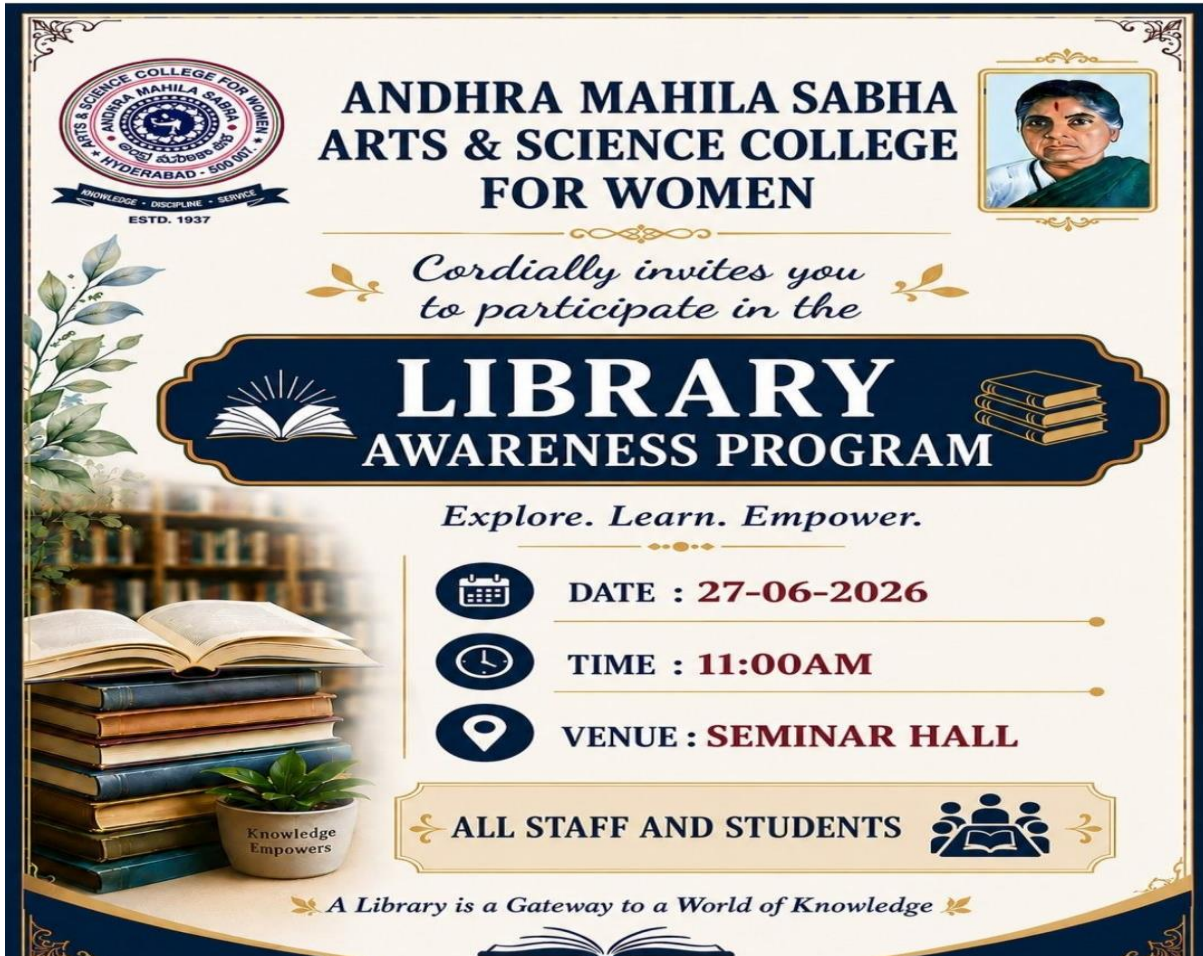
Student Interaction Session
